


#### What Was The Climate Question?

- The original task posed by the 1988 U.N.
   Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change
   (IPCC) ...has man-made carbon dioxide made a measurable, and identifiable impact on global warming? Later changed to climate change, and then to "climate weirding"
- The IPCC is not a research organization; it functions as an international political propaganda entity which assumed from the start that CO2 was the primary driver of climate





The "hockey stick" graph as published in IPCC TAR (Figure 2-20, 2001)





#### Manmade CO2 Contributes +/- 0.2% Of The Total GHG Effect






the magnitude and pattern of the response. Furthermore, many groups have now performed model integrations using similar radiative forcings. This allows ensembles of model results to be constructed (see Chapter 9, Section 9.3; see also the end of Chapter 7, Section 7.1.3 for an interesting question about ensemble formation).

In sum, a strategy must recognise what is possible. In climate research and modelling, we should recognise that we are dealing with a coupled non-linear chaotic system, and therefore that the long-term prediction of future climate states is not possible




#### What Is The Real-World Answer To Date?


- Computer models designed to answer basic questions have failed when compared to the real-world, historical, climate record
- Climate computer models fail the test of prediction, particularly at the regional level
- The sought-for, man-made component is very small and is buried amongst the natural effects of variable atmospheric aerosols, poorly-understood cloud feedback mechanisms, and a variety of solar influences

#### The "Denier" Accusation

- This is the fallback talking-point of the uninformed.
- Ask: "What do you say I am denying?"
- I accept that the UN's IPCC 2007 states that the direct effect of doubling the level of atmospheric CO2 results in a 1.2°C increase in global temperature.
- I accept that to get the 3 to 4 or more degrees of total warming projected by the IPCC, some sort of climate feedback mechanism is necessary.
- Ask: Please provide me with the scientific paper which provides the observed evidence for this claimed amplification mechanism.

- Weather is not climate; temperature is not climate


#### Oregon Coast March 13, 2012 Most Snow Since 1950s

- The authors conclude "While relative sea level continues to rise at some of the highest rates found along the U.S. Atlantic Coast, there is presently no evidence of a statistically significant increase marking an acceleration in relative sea-level rise" at any of the 5 Bay stations measured
- The land is sinking, rather than the sea level rising

### "Cool Counties" Climate Stabilization Declaration

- A 2007 Sierra Club initiative
- Objective: Counties are to resolve to reduce regional greenhouse gas emissions 80% by 2050
- Why? In response to the unproved claim that manmade greenhouse gases are causing detectible and harmful climate change
- How will we know when the climate is "stable"?






#### Agenda21

Agenda 21 is a comprehensive plan of action to be taken globally, nationally and locally by organizations of the United Nations System, Governments, and Major Groups in every area in which human impacts on the environment.

Agenda 21, the Rio Declaration on Environment and Development, and the Statement of principles for the Sustainable Management of Forests were adopted by more than 178 Governments at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) held in Rio de Janerio, Brazil, 3 to 14 June 1992.

The Commission on Sustainable Development (CSD) was created in December 1992 to ensure effective follow-up of UNCED, to monitor and report on implementation of the agreements at the local, national, regional and international levels. It was agreed that a five year review of Earth Summit progress would be made in 1997 by the United Nations General Assembly meeting in special session.

The full implementation of Agenda 21, the Programme for Further Implementation of Agenda 21 and the Commitments to the Rio principles, were strongly reaffirmed at the World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD) held in Johannesburg, South Africa from 26 August to 4 September 2002.



# What Are The Objectives of "Sustainable Development"?

- Objectives include the linking of economic, social, and environmental policies in order to reduce human consumption, achieve social equity, and preserve biodiversity
- It is predicated on alarmist claims of human caused destruction of the environment
- This global goal is to be achieved using central planning and control techniques at each level of government to regulate private property ownership and individual freedom



## U.S. *National Research Council* Provides The EPA A Sustainability Mandate

- At the request of EPA, the National Research Council (NRC) issued an August 2011 report providing an "operational framework for integrating sustainability into the regulatory responsibilities of EPA."
- Referencing President Obama's 2009 Executive Order (13514), the NRC report uses the President's definition of sustainability contained in the order...sustainability means "to create and maintain conditions, under which humans and nature can exist in harmony, that permit fulfilling the social, economic, and other requirements of present and future generations."

# Biodiversity And Environmental Impact Become The New ICLEI Benchmarks For Land Use

- U.N. derived policy contradicts the basic U.S.
   Constitutional/unalienable rights of its citizens
- Ownership of private property was seen as a core component of the U.S. Constitution by the founding fathers
- A gradual erosion of private property rights by over-reaching land use regulations based on "sustainability" and "biodiversity" is embodied in Agenda 21, Rio+20, and ICLEI policy
