Worried About Running Out of Petroleum Oil?

- Peak Oil: Originated by M. King Hubbert 1956
- His prediction was for US oil production to peak between 1965 and 1970
- US production did peak for a time in 1970
- Hubbert predicted maximum possible US oil production by 2011 as one billion barrels
- Actual 2011 production was two billion barrels

Earlier Peak Oil Predictions

- 1920: US Geological Survey estimated world contained 60 billion barrels of recoverable oil
- To date 1000 billion barrels have been produced with 1500 billion barrels in reserve
- Conventional world oil resources are estimated to be in the neighborhood of 10,000 billion barrels

Hubbert's Scarcity Predictions Fail

- World oil production would peak in 2000 at 12.5 billion barrels
- Fact: World oil production 2011 was 26.5 billion barrels, and increasing
- Hubbert's natural gas prediction for 2010 was 4 TCF
- Fact: 2010 US production was 26TCF

Hubbert Unable to Devine the Future and Future Technologies


- Western US estimate to hold 2000 billion barrels of oil in oil shale deposits
- At the rate of our average yearly consumption that is a 286 year supply
- US predicted to be top oil producer in 2020


Production Turns Up...

U.S. field output of crude (thousand barrels/day)




And Drilling Jumps...
